Team competition is open preferably for National teams and will be played in the Davis Cup format, with 2 players in each team, playing for the best of 5 matches. If there is place for more teams, we will allow clubs to enter as well. It's alright to use a third player in the double match.

Limitations:

Players are allowed to participate in one event on Friday, two events on Saturday and one event on Sunday.

In Men's Singles the maximum number of entrance in the qualification round is 144 players and **16 players** will be directly qualified to Friday's final knock-out stage.

In Women's Singles the maximum number of entrance in the qualification round is 64 players and **16 players** will be directly qualified to Saturday's final knock-out stage.

The final knock-out rounds in Men's Singles will be played on Friday and Women's Singles will be held on Saturday.

Entries:

The date of birth has to be given in the entry form. Players shall be listed in order of playing level.

The organizer has the right to enter four "wild card" players in each event.

Girls are not allowed to participate in the boys' events.

The entry must be given to the organizer no later than 10th October 2008.

Seeding:

Seeding will be set up by the World, European and Swedish rankings and in cooperation with the Swedish Association national board.

Draw:

The draws for knock-out events will be made in Ängby office on Thursday 20 November.

The draws for the group events will be made after check-in (1 hour before start) at the playing venue on the day of competition.
