If the number of entries received on the day of deadline exceeds the maximum number for any event, the lowest ranked entries will be returned. Entries from international clubs or associations will not be returned. In men's single 8-16 players will be seeded directly to play-off, In women's single 4-8 players will be seeded directly to play-off.

### **LIMITATIONS**

Thursday a player can only play in one team Sunday a player in 12 cannot play in 16

#### **SEEDING**

Seedings for the Men's and Women's Open Singles will be determined first according to the ITTF World Ranking Top 200, then according to the current Swedish ranking. Seeding for other events will be determined according to the current Swedish ranking. However, international players may be seeded, after consideration by Swedish national team captain and high performance director.

Sweden Tour uses the policy of equal price money for men and women. A total of SEK 40,000 will be awarded in the Open events and SEK 24,000 in the Youth 20 and 17 events.

Price money for the Open events may be reduced in case of low participation.
