COMPETITION POINTS

As a Sweden Tour Pro event, the tournament awards quadruple competition points in accordance with Chapter 10 of the SBTF Competition Regulations. These points count towards qualification for the Swedish Championships.

SEEDING

All Sweden Tour PRO events shall be seeded in accordance with the SBTF Competition Regulations. The current Swedish ranking list will form the basis for seeding, both for Swedish players and for foreign players with a Swedish ranking.

For foreign players without a Swedish ranking, the tournament management will make a preliminary seeding, which will then be reviewed by the SBTF Seeding Committee.

RESTRICTIONS REGARDING MULTIPLE ENTRIES

- Thursday Oct 29: A player may only participate in one team, not several.
- Saturday Oct 31: A player may only participate in either Youth 14 or 18, not both.
- Sunday Nov 1: Players in Youth 12 may not participate in Youth 16.

Men's & Women's Open single:	SEK 500
Boys & Girls Youth 20	SEK 250
Boys' & Girls' Youth 16, 18	SEK 300
Boys' & Girls' Youth 12, 14	SEK 250

Butterfly Team Events fees: SEK 600/per team

Entry fee(s) will be invoiced to the registering club.

REGISTRATION

Entries must be submitted **no later than September 23**. Please include the player's name, date of birth, club or national team, and the event(s) entered. Entries should be sent by e-mail to tournament@angby.com.

If the number of entries on the final entry date exceeds the maximum number of participants in an event, the lowest ranked players will be removed. Entries from international clubs or associations will not be removed.

In Men's Singles, 8–16 players will be seeded directly into the play-off.

In Women's Singles, 4–8 players will be seeded directly into the play-off.

PRIZE MONEY

Equal distribution of prize money applies in men's and women's events.

3-4	SEK 3,000	SEK 1,000
5-8	SEK 1,500	SEK 500

In case of low participation, the prize money in the open events may be reduced.



Prize money will not be paid in cash but transferred to the bank account provided by the prize winner. Any taxes are the responsibility of the player.
